



Volunteer Tutor Position Description

Overview

The Tutoring Club @ Deerbrook is an initiative established in partnership with Deerbrook Covenant Church to invest in the lives of Lee's Summit youth, their families, and the community. As a Partner in Education with Meadow Lane Elementary School, Deerbrook has the heart, resources, and the ideal location for this program.

Description of Responsibilities

Provide academic assistance, mentorship, and encouragement to a Kindergarten through 6th grade student who you will be matched with for the duration of the club year.

Time Commitment

The Tutoring Club @ Deerbrook will run on Mondays and Tuesdays from September 2022 to April 2023 (for a total of 24 weeks). You will be matched with your student for a one-hour time slot on Mondays or Tuesdays between 4:00 and 6:30 pm, based upon your availability. There will also be a required volunteer training session prior to the beginning of the club year, with the possibility of additional training provided during the program year.

Positively impact the life of a youth both academically and personally with the support of The Tutoring Club @ Deerbrook Program Coordinator and other motivated volunteers in a group setting.

Qualifications

Volunteers should be at least 18 years old.

Knowledge of basic reading, writing and math skills.

Ability to work with youth in a respectful and caring manner.

Ability and desire to motivate youth to improve their academic skills.

Ability to set and maintain clear boundaries.

Effective communication skills, dependable, patient, and have a heart for helping Lee's Summit youth succeed.
